July 11, 2023

Swim Team (Meredith)

- Relay Carnival went well, no community disruption, used Church & school parking
- Record 3 wins, 1 loss
- Audit sent by Melissa to Scott in June (will forward to BOT)
- Ice cream sales, Schawn running low on supplies, switching to Costco

Crystal Aquatics (CA) - Jeff Collins

- Facility evaluation possible submission by late July to support the August draft budget prep
- Discussed options for Glen Eagles (GE) pump maintenance service, will include in facility evaluation
- Incident with a toddler at Oak Chase (OC) pool who was able to leave kiddy pool area
 - upgraded gate to a pullup lock
 - will not have music playing from office
 - Pool committee decision to not allow music at either pool
- Diagram of Pools would be useful for incident reporting
- Discussion of the lifeguards interactions with large numbers of guests attending multiple parties
 - recommended a revision to the pool rules
 - 1-2 quests for children under 18 proposed
 - Basketball hoop causes most issues
- Recommended that we limit in number of parties that can occur at Oak Chase since it puts a strain on lifeguards
 - Pool rules do limit the total number of guests for multiple parties to 25. Approved by the pool manager
 - CA will look at a scheduling process
- Pool Pass photo ID status as of the 7/15 requirement date – no issues
- Lap lane use for swim lessons
 - Will ask the lifeguards to ensure lap swimmers have access to swim lane
- Manifold, pump, stater needed for Glen Eagles

Maintenance

- Will replace shower heads, performed temporary repair
- GE shed doors deposit sent

- Had a couple of false security alarms at GE, the men's bathroom door needs repair

Furniture

- Nuria email sent Umbrella Condition Report as of 7/2:
 - GE: Good condition overall
 - OC: 1 Funbrella has mildew/dirty white panels
 - 1 patio umbrella has a damaged rib to stretcher connection; panel is partially collapsed.
 - 1 patio umbrella needs a stretcher pocket reattached to secure rib in place.
- Furniture needs to be tagged before Labor Day
- Grill maintenance needed a GE, igniters not functioning
 - Heather will ask handy man to check these
- Looking at purchasing new grills
- We will need to prepare a maintenance schedule
